Who I Help

I work with everyday pet owners whose dogs have **separation-related issues**, from mild whining and barking to more severe anxiety. My goal is to help your dog feel confident and comfortable when you're not home.

What You'll Get From Working With Me

You'll get a clear plan, simple short training plans to follow, and support between sessions so you're never guessing. Our aim in training is to teach your dog to become confident and happy alone. The most effective way to do this is to do gradual exposure to being left alone. Making sure at every step there is not fear being exhibited, so they learn alone time is not scary.

How I Work (Kind, Evidence-Led, No Aversives)

All methods used are kind, ethical and **never involve leaving your dog or puppy to cry out**. In fact, we will be asking you to commit to **NOT leaving your dog** home alone outside of training. Leaving them home alone for longer than they can cope will only **reinforce the fear**. We know it's a **big ask**, but success in separation anxiety training isn't possible without it.

Toby a 2 year old maltipoo: Toby’s guardians struggled to leave the room without Toby and he would follow them to the bathroom! After 8 weeks of training Toby is already able to spend 30 minutes home alone allowing his mum a peaceful soak in the bath or a trip to the shop every so often!

Is This Right For You? (Safety & Scope)

I’m a trainer, not a vet. If I suspect pain or a medical issue, I’ll ask you to see your vet before training. For severe cases, I may recommend a vet check or a clinical behaviourist. Your dog’s safety and welfare come first.

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FAQs

- Can we have a phone call before I commit?

Yes I offer discovery calls for £10. [You can book one here.](#) We can discuss your training goals and I may be able to give some baseline advice however it is not a substitute for a consultation. The price of the call will be deducted from your first session/package.

- What training methods do you use?

Reward-based, welfare-first training. I teach alternative behaviours and set you up to succeed without fear or pain.

- Do you guarantee results?

No ethical trainer can guarantee behaviour, but I do guarantee professional effort, a clear plan, and support between sessions. Your practice and consistency make the difference.

- Where do sessions take place?

All of my separation anxiety support is offered virtually, it is not possible to train a dog to be happy home alone with a stranger(me) in your home.

- What equipment do I need?

You will need 2 or 3 internal cameras (the recommendations for these will be included in your assessment), a smart phone and ideally a laptop (for the assessment only).

- Can children attend?

Yes, if your children will be involved in training I recommend they attend the assessment.

- What's your cancellation policy?

The training is relatively flexible and cancelled sessions can be rescheduled at my discretion.
